Guidelines and Judging

Criteria:

- Student may NOT be released from any regular class to work on decorations until 3rd

period Wednesday. It is up to the discretion of a sponsor whether a grade level group uses class time, but time should be limited so that no class has an unfair advantage.

- Decorations may be worked on outside of class hours with supervision (breaks, before or after school)
- The wall should have a unifying theme throughout
- Avoid offensive or inappropriate words, graphics, or content

400 pts	Theme supports school spirit and pride
300 pts	Evidence of thought, planning, and team work
300 pts	Pleasing composition and workmanship (color, quality of graphics, arrangement)
300 pts	Showcases candidates or class
200 pts	Originality and creativity are evident

Homecoming Floats (9-12 only) (after game Friday)

Candidates will ride into stadium on “float” vehicles from south entrance, circle to east side, and stop to unload candidates. A brief description of the float (theme, catch phrase, etc.) MUST be turned in to Mrs. Vowell by Thursday, October 23, or points are deducted.

Judging Criteria for Float:

- **Vehicle is appropriate** **50**
- **Originality/Creativity apparent** **200**
- **Candidates are all involved** **50**
- **Supports school spirit** **100**

Servant Rules

If a student (or group of students) buys a “servant,” they must pay the money by **Thursday, October 1**. They cannot bid unless they have a check or cash ready AT THE TIME OF BIDDING. Servitude begins Monday.

Buyers must not make the servant do anything which violates beliefs or morals, which causes undue embarrassment, or which demeans or ridicules the servant. Servitude begins Monday at 8:00 and ends Thursday at 4:00.

If the servant is to “perform” at the Homecoming pep rally, Mrs. Vowell must be notified at least one day ahead.
